This is the fourth racing season Ross Chastain has been sponsored by the Moose. Chastain drives the No. 1 Moose Chevrolet Camaro four times in the NASCAR Cup Series this year, the first when he finished 23rd in the GEICO 500 at Talladega Superspeedway in Alabama in April.

In addition to the four races where Chastain wears the Moose fire suit and drives the Moose-emblazoned Camaro, Chastain is a spokesman for the Fraternity year-round and the Moose is an associate sponsor of his car throughout the NASCAR season.

A committed Moose, Chastain is a 5 Club member, his family are all Moose members and not only has he visited Mooseheart and Moosehaven, but numerous lodges across the U.S.

Who is the most difficult driver you've faced?

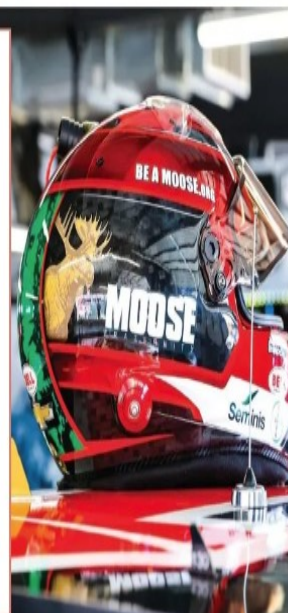
