“Christmas In October,” helps to ensure that those entrusted to our care are able to have a prosperous holiday season.



For decades and through the efforts of the Mooseheart/Moosehaven Committee, the Women of the Moose have celebrated “Christmas In October,” to ensure that those entrusted to our care are able to have a prosperous holiday season.

For many years, members provided gifts of toys, clothing and other items of need for our children and senior members. However, many of the items proved to be inappropriate for the recipient’s needs or simply the wrong size. As a result, “Christmas In October” became a monetary donation event. In that way, staff at Mooseheart and Moosehaven could shop for the right present depending on likes, dislikes and need.

Each year, chapters conduct a gift walk for both Mooseheart and Moosehaven, in which monetary donations are collected from members and remitted to Women of the Moose headquarters. Chapters are also asked to remit a donation of \$35 or more to purchase a special gift for both a child and a senior.

Our Mooseheart children also know that, because of the Women of the Moose, they will have a joyful Christmas season. We provide funds for photo Christmas cards, Christmas parties in each residence, holiday decorations and special treats. There is friendly competition to be the best-decorated home and to have the best-decorated tree.

At Moosehaven, the Women of the Moose provide funds for a variety of special events. These include the annual Christmas dinner and party, the New Year’s Eve party, Thanksgiving dinner, off-campus trips. We also provide funds for many on-campus monthly social gatherings, including events at the Health Care Center. These gatherings afford residents the opportunity to sing, dance and laugh the night away.

Generally, music, food and beverage are provided to our residents through the generosity of the Women of the Moose. Moosehaven staff members, who give of their personal time to attend, enjoy these many events as well.

Chapters are encouraged to celebrate this special time - decorate the meeting room in a Christmas theme, have a potluck before or after the meeting and play or sing Christmas carols. Some chapters schedule a visit from Santa and serve Christmas cookies and treats. Generally, the Women of the Moose have a lot of “seasonal fun” celebrating Christmas in October.

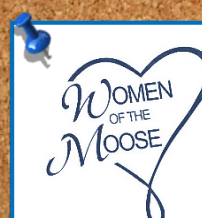

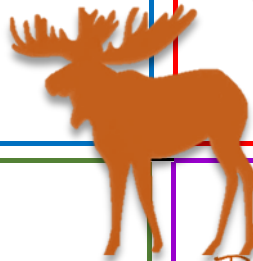

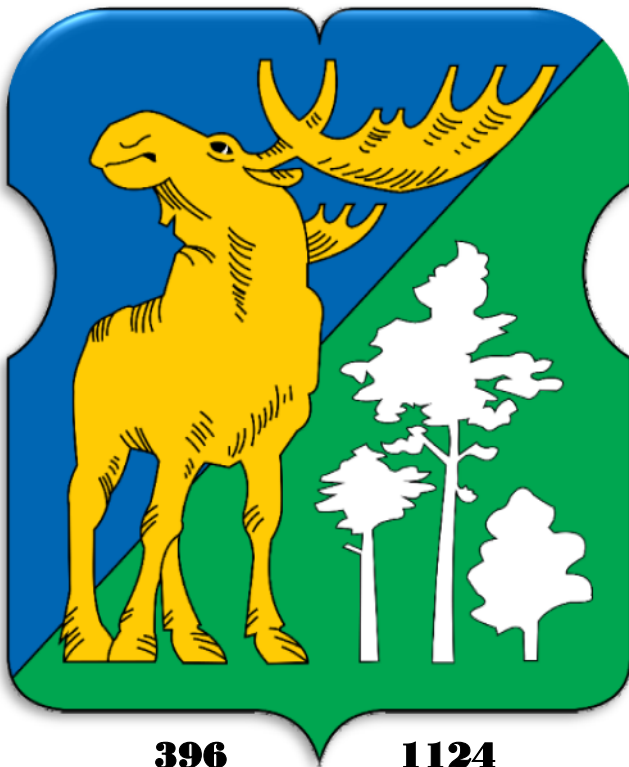
