Through this year's membership campaign, we seek to raise awareness of the Fraternity in the communities we serve ... inviting them to join with us in mutual support of their/our community.

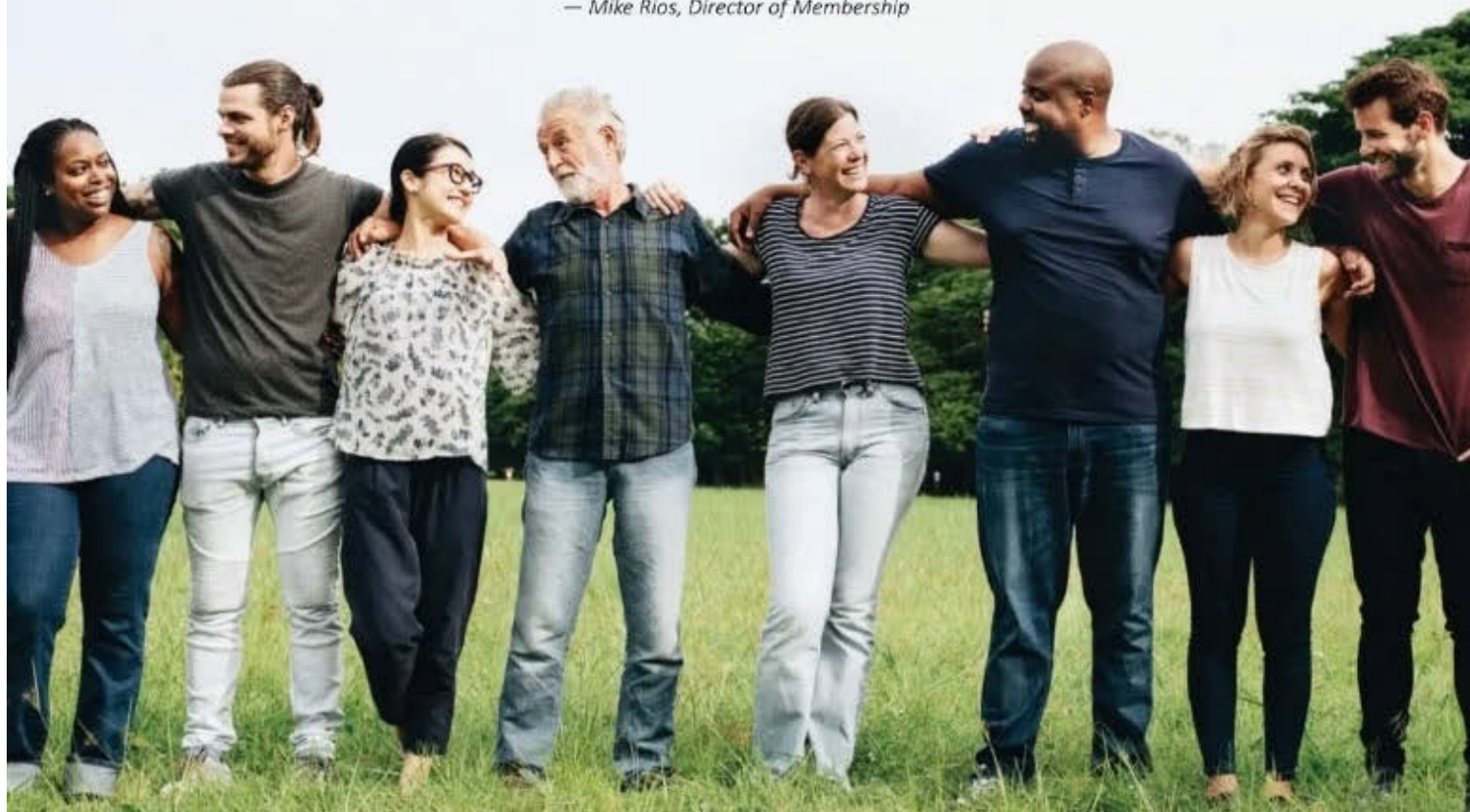
